# 10. Recipe of the Month.

#### Orange Squash

#### Ingredients: -

Orange Juice – 1 Litre Sugar – 1.7 Kgs
Water – 1.3 Litres C.A(Citric Acid)-30 gms( 6 level tsp)
Orange Essence – 20 gm (4 level tsp) Orange Red Colour – little
K.M.S (Potassium Meta-bisulphate) – 3.2 gms (1 tsp)

#### Method: -

Select ripe juicy sweet limes or oranges. Wash thoroughly in cold water. Cut fruits into halves and extract juice with the help of orange juice extractor. In case of oranges, peels can be removed and segments passed through juice extractor. Even mixie can be used. After extraction, strain juice and measure. Take the full ingredients for preparation of squash. Take sugar, water and citric acid in a vessel, heat to boiling point, filter and cool sugar syrup. To cold syrup add orange juice. Mix well. Add orange essence and orange red colour. Finally add the preservative, K.M.S which is dissolved in a little water to the squash. Mix thoroughly and pour in clean and sterile bottles leaving half headspace. Cork and store in a cool dry place.
